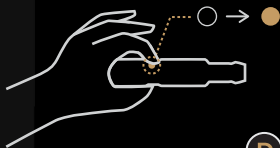
# THE DANI VER3TI

## 02 METAL STEM

Block the airhole on the stem while drawing vapors.



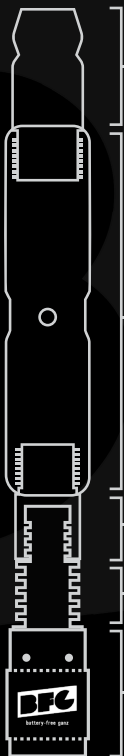

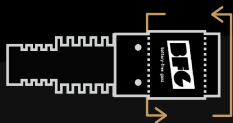

## HOW TO ADJUST AIRFLOW?



rotate anti-clockwise 1-1.5 turn to open and start adjusting the airflow

Put the cap on and screw it until it stops (if you turn, it's going to be tight), back it off a turn or a turn and a half whatever you feel comfortable with, this is required because the airflow is going to get through to the tip.

If you leave that tight, **1)** you will not be able to draw because you're closing airflow completely **2)** when you heat that, the cap will expand a little bit, and you're not going to be able to unscrew it until it's cool down. So this action means adjusting the airflow; you could try to draw the vape to feel the airflow change.



### HERB FILLING

Just don't pack it super tight, you could fill full bowl or half bowl.

### BATTERY FREE GANZ

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### HEATING IT UP!!!

No need to rotate



#### POSITION 1

Among air holes, more "conduction" vapors.

#### POSITION 2

Right at the silver band, more "convection" vapors.

### CLICK!!!

You can repeat

When it clicks, you reach the vaporization range and can draw your vapors here.



If you like thicker vapors, go past the click for a few seconds. Draw all vapors until it clicks again, and you can heat up again from here. You could continually have 2-4 heat cycles with one full bowl of herbs.

Fill D'chamber with herb

**B**

Draw to feel the airflow change

**C**

Heating D'cap no need to rotate

Start drawing until it clicks again

Repeat C to E 1-3 more times to finish your bowl
